Women Leaders Without Limitations Launch!

On March 3rd, 2024, the Wise Women Plumbing Cooperative (WWPC) proudly launched the Women Leaders Without Limitations (WLWL) program. The event was attended by key partners including the **Canadian Ambassador**, Mr. Tarik Ali Khan, the **Country Director of WUSC** Ms. Nancy Al Momani, and the **Secretary General** Mr. Wael Al Dwairi from the Ministry of Water and Irrigation.

Funded by the World University Service of Canada (WUSC), the WLWL program is a groundbreaking initiative promoting sustainability and empowerment. With a focus on inclusive training for visually impaired individuals, the program will educate a 100 participants, 85% of whom are women.

The program extends beyond traditional plumbing instruction by teaching skills in water conservation and sustainability. This practical knowledge fosters personal independence and contributes to sustainable water management in areas with scarcity.

OUR NEW INTERN


